

Some of the gems from the morning included:

- ✦ Cleaning mealybug using metho
- ✦ Sealing cuts when dividing plants with cinnamon or wood glue (Aquadhere)
- ✦ Using Alginox as an antifungal
- ✦ Popping fertiliser pellets into an empty teabag (available on eBay!) and hanging it above the plant
- ✦ Using large bark (size 4 or 5) for large cattleyas
- ✦ Diagnosing orchid health by analysing leaf condition

And that's just a few of the clever ideas shared!

A huge thank you to President Ray for once again welcoming us into your home and shade houses, and for Masters Michael and Roy attending — your generosity and knowledge make these mornings so enjoyable and valuable.



